There is an axiom

in ranch life that when you are on someone else's property, and you come to a gate, you leave the gate as you found it. If it was closed, close it. If it was open, leave it open. The premise of a closed gate is that it is so because the owner wants to either keep something in or something out!

Inevitably as we look back on a year there are some gates that we are confronted with that we need to either leave open or shut. The things that brought us joy, beauty, holy mirth, or peace we need to leave open for the Master has intended them for blessing. There are other gates that we need to close and keep closed. That, dear friend, is easier said than done. We shut the door at the office, but the office follows us home. We leave a conversation, but the conversation follows us to our beds. We dismiss a thought, but the thought disturbs our sleep. Perhaps this poem will be of help.

F.E Boreham relates this closing of gates to the Exodus story where Pharoah and his army are destroyed. Miriam took up a tambourine and commemorated the event with a song;

"Sing to the Lord, for he has triumphed gloriously; the horse and rider he has thrown into the sea."

We need to remember what God had done as a way of closing the gate on the past for his people. Look into Exodus 14:19 and see how the angel of God moved before the people. He went behind them and came between the host of Egypt and the host of Israel! God drove back the sea and the Israelites crossed on dry ground. When the Egyptians pursued, God decisively closed the gate, preventing the Egyptians from pursuing AND effectively closing the gate for the Israelites to return.

Is there something, or several things that you need to close the gate on? Paul says, "Forgetting what lies behind, and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on for the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." Shut the gate, and look forward!




June 18 - 22
