

WORSHIP & LEAD

What did it for me is that I had men to look up to, men who along the way poured into me and developed me. From these men I learned, and I fell in love with corporate worship. I will always remember my adult worship leader back home in Brenham, TX. He was an old country cowboy who, with a sweet smile and love in his eyes pushed me to passionately hone my skills and fall more in love with Christ. Men like him showed me what it was to be an authentic worship leader, and it set my heart on fire.
