As believers in Jesus Christ, we are called to share the Gospel. Serving others in need provides a great opportunity to do that. Currey Creek has several local mission partners that are looking for believers to come alongside them to help meet the needs of the people in our community. Meadowland

RMYA Meadowland serves children from across Texas, ages 6 – 18, who have been removed from parental custody. Their goal is to work with these children so that they can eventually be relocated to extended family or placed in the foster care/adoption system. Meadowland has bed capacity for up to 80 children, however constraints on staffing and funding limits the number of children in residence to 40-50. The program provides room and board, 24/7/365 staffing at a 1:3 ratio, robust clinical counseling/psychiatric services, charter school education services, on campus pool & gymnasium, and an appropriate schedule of youth activities both on and off the campus.

Ways to get involved:

- Join our Currey Creek volunteers on Meadowland's campus once a month to fellowship and build relationships with a group of kids
- Provide support and encouragement for direct care staff (ex. meals, cards, etc.)
- Volunteer for facilities maintenance (ex. group of handymen to come and complete the monthly “honey-do” list in each of the 5 cabins & counseling center, pool, & gym)
- Funding is always the primary need. The state funds only 55% of the cost of having kids in care



Retreat4Kids

Retreat4Kids provides a Christ-centered, residential center for girls in a time of crisis and abuse. They provide hope and healing through support of foster care services, relational advocacy, and trauma-informed care in a home environment while pursuing family restoration. They offer a therapeutic team approach including programs such as individual therapy and psychological counseling, continued schooling, life skills and voluntary spiritual opportunities to discover true identity and purpose. Retreat4Kids also seeks to influence and equip others who share a similar calling to impact children, families and future generations.

Ways to Get Involved:

- Retreat4Kids need volunteers that help build databases, enter medications and special instructions
- The staff is available to speak to a small group to provide more in-depth information
- You may have a particular skill that can be used to shine a brighter light on the girls we serve. For example, helping with a special event or leading a Bible study
- Funding helps Retreat4Kids pay trained staff and provide the necessary care these girls need



Hill Country Pregnancy Care Center

The Hill Country Pregnancy Care Center exists to promote the value of life and empower individuals to make healthy choices regarding pregnancy and sexuality and to extend the compassion and love of Jesus Christ. They serve about 600 families each year and their services are entirely FREE and confidential. HCPCC is saving lives, strengthening families and educating our community. They offer medical and educational services and provide free resources such as car seats, cribs, clothing, diapers and more.

Ways to Get Involved:

- HCPCC is in need of Spanish Speaking volunteers to help directly with their clients – 50% of them are Spanish speakers and HCPCC has a limited number of advocates to assist
- They are also in need of male Client Advocates who can walk alongside men in fatherhood, education and discipleship
- Donate NEW baby clothes for boys and girls, sizes 3 months - 3T
- As a Helping Hand Volunteer, you can work on projects as needed by the center
- As a Client Advocate, you can receive thorough training to work directly with their clients
- Funding is always needed to help provide free services to families in need
