REGIONAL PARTNERS

NORTHEAST BAPTIST COLLEGE

Started in 2013, NEBC was founded due to the lack of Christian witness in the Northeast. Dr. Ballard had the vision to equip Church Planters and other Christian leaders to go into the towns of Vermont to share the Gospel, plant churches, and send more laborers into not only Vermont, but the entire Northeast. Last year, a group of about 60 people saw 583 people come to faith in Christ!

Did you know? Vermont has a population of about 650,000 and less than 2% evangelical Christian. A predominantly rural state comprised of 251 towns, many of which lack any Gospel witness, the people of Vermont may go their whole lives and never hear the Gospel.

STORY

Dr. Ballard, the president of the Christian college, shared the story of a middle-aged man who had never heard the Gospel in his whole life until they showed up on his doorstep. After receiving Christ, the man surrendered to a call to ministry and now pastors a church.

Interested in going? NEBC received groups that come and do labor on their student housing, to allow them to take more students. Whilst there, you will also go out with their team to share the Gospel with people who may have never heard the Gospel.
