From the time a student enters Upstream until they graduate. we have less than 400 hours with them if they come each Wednesday night, and less than 130 hours on Sunday mornings. Even the most consistent students will likely only have around half that time with us. The window of opportunity is small but significant. Different studies show that between 77% and 94% of Christians choose to follow

Christ before they turn 18 years old. Students who have just one meaningful relationship with an adult in the church who is not their parent are over 80% more likely to follow Jesus in college. It is a privilege and a great challenge to be called to disciple the next generation. We are passionate about leading students in spiritual disciplines, Biblical truth and worldview, and equipping them to share Christ as they engage others locally and globally for the glory of Christ.
