How to Study God's Word

We read God's Word:

- Prayerfully
- Repeatedly
- Patiently
- Meditatively
- Purposefully

Helpful tools:

- A printed copy of the text
- Colored pencils or highlighters
- A dictionary
- A list of God's attributes
- PRAYER

Questions to ask of the text:

- Who wrote it?
- To whom was it written?
- When was it written?
- Why was it written?
- What genre was it written in?
- How does this passage fit into the overarching story of the Bible?
 - Creation, Fall, Redemption, Restoration

Things to see:

- Emphasized
- Repeated
- Lists
- Comparison and Contrast
- Commands and Warnings
- Grammar
- Questions you have about the text

Questions to ask God and ask yourself:

- What do I learn about God's character?
- What do I learn about myself in view of who God is?
- Is there a sin to confess? How do I need to repent or change?
- Is there a truth I need to believe?
- Is there a promise from God to hold onto?
- Is there an example to follow?
- Is there a command to obey?
- Is there a verse to memorize or pray?

Questions to ask others:

- How are you going to apply this passage to your life this week and how can I hold you accountable?
- How can I pray for you this week as you apply this passage to your life?

Attributes of God

God is infinite - He was created by nothing and has always existed forever. He has no limits.

God is immutable - He never changes.

God is self-sufficient - He has no needs.

God is omnipotent - He is all powerful.

God is omniscient - He is all knowing.

God is omnipresent - He is everywhere, all of the time.

God is wise - He is full of perfect, unchanging wisdom.

God is faithful - He is always true to every one of His promises.

God is good - He is the origin of all good. He is infinitely, immutably, and unchangingly good.

God is just – He Is infinitely, unchangeably right and perfect in all he does.

God is merciful – He is infinitely, unchangeably compassionate and kind. He fully demonstrates His mercy in Jesus Christ.

God is gracious - God chooses to bless us rather than curse us as our sin deserves.

God Is loving – God infinitely, unchangingly loves us.

God is Holy – He is perfect in every way, and perfectly good all the time. He is the source and standard of absolute goodness.

God is glorious – He is infinitely beautiful and great.

God is transcendent - He is above, completely other than and independent of creation.

God is jealous - He is possessive of the worship and service that belong to Him.

God is incomprehensible - He is personal and knowable, but we will never understand him exhaustively.

God is self existent - He is the source of all things, the One who originated everything and who sustains everything that exists.

God is long suffering - He is patient with sinners.

God is eternal - He is everlasting with no beginning or end.

God is sovereign - He is in control. He governs all things and is over all things.
