## CONVERSATION STARTER

- In Luke 4, Jesus reads Scripture that was written on a scroll. Have someone make a scroll out of a piece of paper and write out Luke 4:18-19 on it. Then have someone stand up, unroll the scroll, and read it aloud.

## DIG DEEPER

- Read Luke 4:16-21. What does this passage teach us about Jesus? What does Jesus do (vs 18-19)?
- Read Luke 4:21-30. How did the people treat Jesus? Why do you think they treated him this way?
- Do people you know reject Jesus today?
- Though Jesus has many followers, he has also been rejected by many people in the world. They even beat him and hung him on a cross. If Jesus has been rejected by people, how do you think you as his disciple will be treated by others in the world?
- Have you ever felt rejected by others? How does it make you feel to know that Jesus understands what that pain feels like? How can we go to Jesus for help when others reject or hurt us?

- Are there any prayer requests? Spend some time praying for each other and asking God to give you the courage to follow him no matter what it costs.
