

The Missions Apprentice Program at Currey Creek Church is a 6-9-month, part time role. The Missions apprenticeship is designed to provide a person exploring a call to missions through the local church. It is an opportunity to not only gain hands-on ministry experience but to also expose them to the leadership and ministry duties of Currey Creek pastors and staff. Our desire is for this program to give candidates an encounter with the full range of ministerial roles, duties, and expectations within the mission's ministry. The Missions Ministry Apprentice will work on large scale ministry and leadership projects as well as daily ministry duties. The intent will be for candidates to learn, grow and exhibit skills necessary to build and lead teams, execute vision and ultimately prepare them for the next steps of ministry in their life, either at Currey Creek Church or wherever the Lord may lead.

Key Responsibilities

- Attend ministry meetings as requested and bring ideas, creativity, and passion
- Assist in any planning, organizing, and implementation of ministry specific event.
 - Examples: Perspectives implementation at CC, Co-Lead a short-term trip
- Help recruit, train, and empower volunteers to advance missions in either kids or student ministry
- Be the point person for set up of major missions programming and events
- Meet monthly with Currey Creek Directors to grow in leadership, organization, and vision for ministry



- Help to identify, invite, train, and empower adults who have a heart for Jesus and His Mission
- Provide administrative support to the Missions Director as requested
- Aid any ministry needing administrative help when missions' responsibilities have been completed

- Attendance and leadership on 1-2 short term trips
- 1-on-1 personal and spiritual discipleship
- Experience in leading and implement missions' centric initiatives
