Job Summary

The Production Director is responsible for the primary leadership of staff and volunteer production teams at Currey Creek. This position will have direct responsibility for the technical production strategy as well as day to day operations for all ministry productions. Working in collaboration with the Worship Pastor, the Production Director will set and maintain practical standards to ensure the smooth operation of all worship services on campus. This includes administrative duties, system maintenance, and volunteer discipleship.

Key Responsibilities

Technical Leadership

- Oversee the operation and maintenance of all technical and production systems, including audio, video, lighting (including DMX and LED wall programming as appropriate), and live streaming equipment.
- Ensure consistent, high-quality execution of weekend services, midweek events, and special productions.
- Strong ability to troubleshoot technical issues quickly and effectively while under pressure.

Volunteer Training, Discipleship & Team Development

- Recruit, train and disciple a high-capacity team of volunteers with clear development pathways for live production roles, fostering a sense of purpose and spiritual growth, and empowering the team with opportunities to run production programs with efficiency and confidence.
- Maintain a culture of encouragement, accountability, and excellence within the team.
- Model servant leadership, prioritizing relationships and spiritual development alongside technical excellence.

Planning & Coordination

- Collaborate with the Worship Pastor and other ministry leaders to plan, create and execute engaging worship services and events.
- Participate in weekly planning review meetings to align production elements with the mission and vision of Currey Creek.
- Manage live production and technical schedules, volunteer rotations, and rehearsals to ensure smooth operations.
- May be called to execute or plan with volunteers various special events, Easter Sunday, on-site weddings/funerals and other church events

Stewardship of Resources

- Oversee the care, maintenance, inventory accountability and organization of all production and technical equipment and spaces.
- Develop, manage, and strategically plan for future technical needs, providing strategic recommendations for upgrades, connectivity or life cycle replacements.
- Collaborate with the Worship Pastor and Director of Finance to develop and appropriately manage budgeted expenses responsibly, maximizing resources to support ministry goals.

Personal and Spiritual Growth

- Maintain a vibrant personal relationship with Jesus Christ, modeling a life of prayer, humility, and integrity.
- Regularly participate in church services and events to stay connected with the broader church community.
- Pursue opportunities for personal development, both spiritually and professionally.
