

Small Group Discussion Questions:

1. Read Genesis 39:6-12. What stands out to you about Joseph? How did he handle the temptation of Potiphar's wife? Who does Joseph not want to sin against? Why is that important? What can you learn from Joseph from this passage?
2. Read James 1:13-15. When you give in to sin, who's fault is it? God? Satan? Another person? You? Explain your answer.
3. Discuss the difference between an ice island (CULTURE) and ice berg (CHRIST) as it relates to 1)us as human beings 2)our sexual intimacy.
4. Why is the question: 'How far is too far?' such a dangerous question? What is a better question we could ask in regards to sexual purity?
5. Read 2 Timothy 2:22. You are a 'youth'. What are some youthful passions you see amongst teenagers today? What are you (as a Christ follower) to do with these youthful passions? When you flee, where should you be running? Would it help if you were running with other people who are moving the same direction? Are the people you choose to be friends with helping you to swim upstream? If not, why not?
