LOOK UP

- 1. Read I Peter 1:10-12
- 2. Peter ties the salvation of his readers to the message of the O.T. prophets. Why is this significant?
- 3. Why did the prophets "search... and inquire carefully...",? What was it they were looking for? Do we? Why or why not?
- 4. What were the prophets inquiring about? (answer: Person and time, i.e. context)
- 5. The prophets understood that their ministry was NOT for them, but others in the future. How would Currey Creek change if we all took the attitude of the O.T. prophets and began to see our ministry in the context of future generations?
- 6. How did the gospel come to Peter's readers according to v.12? Who sent them? What was their message? Why is Peter telling them this?
- 7. Peter tells these beleaguered believers that supernatural beings are stooping over and continuously looking in to their salvation. Why would he tell them that?
- 8. Who are the three entities that Peter has listed that would have an interest in his reader's salvation? Why should this matter to us?
