- 6. What does that teach us about being in an accountable relationship?
- 7. What motivated the people to begin building again?
- 8. Notice both Divine and human elements were involved in the good news Nehemiah brought. What lessons can be learned from this?
- 9. Can we expect opposition when we are about God's work? What Bible verses come to mind?
